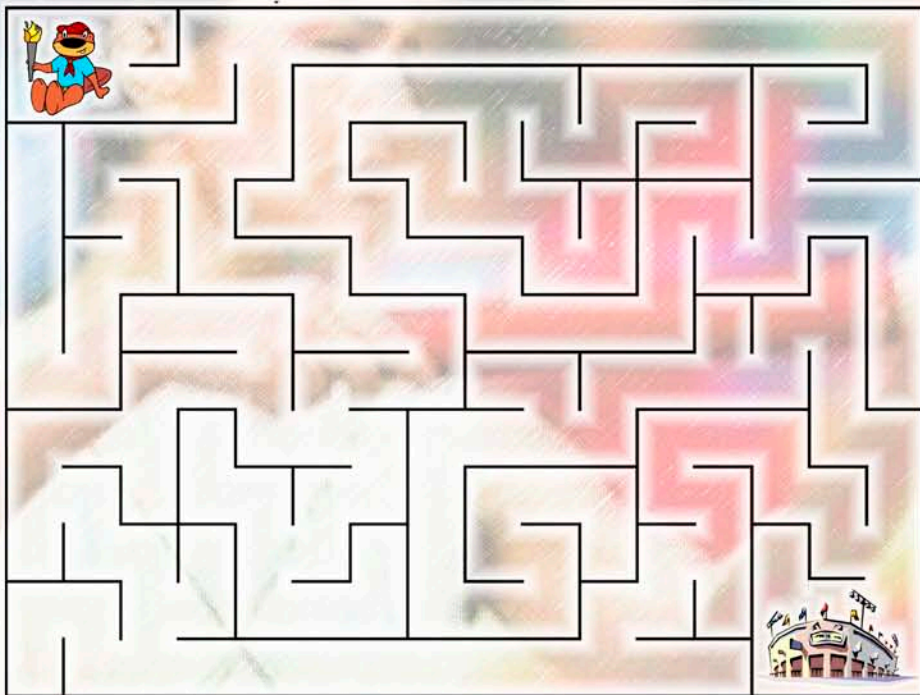


## The Great Olympic Maze

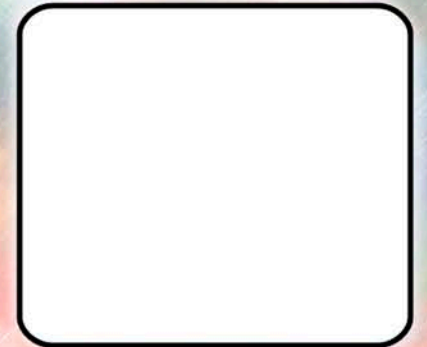
